



INFORMATION FOR TUBERCULOSIS TESTING

In order to enter hospitals and clinics, students must complete a tuberculosis test **within 30 days of our start date**. You have the option of a one-time blood draw or taking skin tests. The blood draw is the most costly option. If you are interested in this, please contact your physician's office and insurance company for coverage information.
